• Moderate to heavy rainfall very likely at most places on 21st to 25th June 2022 • Heavy rainfall at a few places with very heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely on 21st to 25th June 2022 • Maximum & minimum temperatures are likely to be around 26°C & 24°C respectively Week 1 (June 17th – June 23rd) • Rainfall is very likely to be below normal • Maximum temperature is likely to be normal • Minimum temperature is likely to be normal Week 2 (June 24th – June 30th) • Rainfall is very likely to be above normal • Maximum temperature is likely to be normal • Minimum temperature is likely to be normal

General Advisory:

• Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during 21st to 24th June 2022 • Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during the above mentioned period

SMS Advisory:

• Provide mechanical support to young plants and seedlings to minimize the damage • Avoid sowing of seeds, application of fertilizers and chemicals

RICE	• In the view of moderate rainfall to heavy rainfall at most of the places during next 5 days, farmers are advised to postpone the nursery sowing of Kharif paddy • In the areas wherever sowing is completed, it is advised to make arrangements to drain out excess water
CASHEW	• Provide proper drainage to drain out excess water • Provide mechanical support to young plants and seedlings to minimize the damage • Avoid spraying of chemicals and application of fertilizers

Live Stock Specific Advisory:

COW	• If not vaccinated in previous month, vaccinate cattle and buffalo against FMD/Hemorrhagic Septicemia (HS), Anthrax, Black Quarter in this month • Deworming should be done in the beginning of the monsoon season and throughout the season as worms develop at a greater rate during this period. • In rainy season, dairy animals suffer with tick infestation • Farmers can spray ectoparasiticides like cypermethrin or deltamethrin 2-4% on animals' body and also in the shed

Fishieries Specific Advisory:

CARP	The water level in the pond should be maintained at 2 to 2.5 m letting the excess water drain out • Stocking of carp fish fingerings (80-100 mm) @5000-7000 no/ha may be followed based on the seed availability • Feeding of groundnut oil cake: Wheat bran (1:1) ratio at 5-6% of total biomass of the Stock (Total weight of stock) may be followed • Net fences may be provided around the bunds if any issue of wild aquatic animals (crocodiles, otters)			

Poultry Specific Advisory:

Poultry(Varieties)	Poultry Specific Advisory
BIRD	• Prevent the feed ingredients from getting wet, and the amount of feed should not be too much • The compound feed in the house should be placed on the platform above the ground to prevent the feed from regaining moisture • Regular checking of feeders to avoid fungus contamination • Provide your birds with warm water periodically during this rainy season to encourage consumption and help them keep warm without using up energy reserved in the process • Supplementary feeding should be given to the scavenging birds in backyard
