• Squally wind with wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over south maharashtra-goa coast on 4th and 5th august 2022. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas during above mentioned period

• Possibility of heavy to very heavy rainfall during next 5 days. Hence farmers are advised to make arrangements to drain out excess water from the fields and to postpone application of fertilizers

cow	• Due to forecast of heavy rainfall during next 5 days, keep the animals indoor • In rainy season, dairy animals suffer with tick infestation. Farmers can spray ectoparasiticides like cypermethrin or deltamethrin 2-4% on animals' body and also in the shed • If fever, shivering, brown coloured urine, off feed etc. are noticed, consult veterinary doctor immediately • Apply lime in and around shed which causes disinfection and keep floor dry • Make silage from surplus green fodder for easy storage and use during the lean period

CARP	The water level in the pond should be maintained at 2 to 2.5 m letting the excess water drain out • Stocking of carp fish fingerings (80-100 mm) @5000-7000 no/ha may be followed based on the seed availability • Feeding of groundnut oil cake: Wheat bran (1:1) ratio at 5-6% of total biomass of the Stock (Total weight of stock) may be followed • Net fences may be provided around the bunds if any issue of wild aquatic animals (crocodiles, otters)

	• Prevent the feed ingredients from getting wet, and the amount of feed should not be too much • The compound feed in the house should be placed on the platform above the ground to prevent the feed from regaining moisture • Regular checking of feeders to avoid fungus contamination • Provide your birds with warm water periodically during this rainy season to encourage consumption and help them keep warm without using up energy reserved in the process • Supplementary feeding should be given to the scavenging birds in backyard
