(xi) *Quantum of subsidy and eligibility.*—

(a) All Fishermen Societies/Associations registered under the Co-operative Societies Act shall be eligible for financial assistance to the extent of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) as Grant-in-aid.

(b) The members of the Societies/Associations should be actively engaged in fishing activities at Sea/Inland fishing/fish/shrimp farming.

### Notification

Sub.- "Financial Assistance to Brackish Water Aquaculture Farms".

The Government of Goa hereby introduces the new scheme namely, "Financial Assistance to Brackish Water Aquaculture Farms" to increase fish production through aquaculture (Centrally Sponsored Scheme).

### Financial Assistance to Brackish Water Aquaculture Farms

(i) *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This scheme may be called as "Financial Assistance to Brackish Water Aquaculture Farms".

(2) It shall come into force from the date of its notification in the Official Gazette.

(ii) *Introduction.*— It has been observed that the Coastal Aquaculture in the State of Goa provides employment and livelihood

support to considerable number of people. With the enhancement of the Coastal Aquaculture Act, 2005, there is a good scope to increase the Coastal Aquaculture activities through implementation of good management practices, which ultimately will help to increase the total fish production in the State. With this idea the above named new scheme has been designed. The implementation of the scheme will start from the date of its notification in the Official Gazette.

(iii) *Objective of the scheme.*— (a) To increase fish production through aquaculture.

(b) To revive the aquaculture farms which have stopped operation due to high operational cost.

(iv) *Scope of the scheme.*— The scheme envisages to increase the coastal aquaculture activities through implementation of good management practices and resulting in increase in total fish production in the State. The scheme will have three components:

(a) Financial Assistance for construction and renovation of farms.

(b) Financial Assistance for purchase of farming equipments.

(c) Financial Assistance for purchase of feed.

(v) *Beneficiaries.*— All registered fish and shrimp farmers.

(vi) *Pattern of Assistance of the Scheme.*—

(a) *Financial Assistance for Construction and renovation of farms.*— Financial Assistance will be provided as subsidy i.e. 25% subsidy of the cost of construction or renovation of farms/bandhs etc., limited to Rs. 2.00 lakh per ha of which Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees Forty five thousand) per ha will be the Central share. Aquaculture farmers will be eligible for renovation of farm after 5 years of its construction.

(b) *Financial Assistance for purchase of farming equipments.*— 50% of the cost limited

to Rs. 1.00 lakh per ha will be provided in the subsidy for purchase of farm equipments like aerators, pumps, crates, ice boxes, etc. Farmers will be eligible for the subsidy after 5 years.

(c) *Financial Assistance for purchase of feed.*— 25% subsidy on the cost of feed limited to Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) per crop per ha for 2 crops in a year. Farmers will be eligible for the subsidy every year.

(vii) *Terms and conditions of the scheme.*— (a) Beneficiaries should be small farmers having water spread area of 2 ha or less.

(b) Farms owned by farmers should be licensed by Coastal Aquaculture Authority.

(viii) *Procedure to file an application.*— Application forms will be available in all the B. D. O. offices and filled in forms in all respects will be forwarded to the Directorate of Fisheries through concerned B. D. O. offices.

(ix) *Scrutiny Committee.*— Scrutiny Committee will be comprised of Director of Fisheries, Dy. Director of Fisheries, Superintendent of Fisheries and Assistant Superintendent of Fisheries and the eligible application shall be recommended for assistance under the scheme to the Director of Fisheries.

(x) *Disbursement Procedure.*— The applications of the beneficiaries found eligible shall be sanctioned financial assistance in the form of subsidy. The Accounts Officer will draw the amount & disburse the financial assistance through E. C. S. mode of payment in favour of the respective beneficiary.

(xi) *Quantum of subsidy and eligibility.*— (a) Subsidy will be 25% of cost of construction or renovation of farms/bandhs limited to Rs. 2.00 lakh per ha of which Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees forty five thousand) per ha will be Central share.

(b) 50% subsidy of the cost limited to Rs. 1.00 lakh per ha for purchase of farm

equipments like aerators, pumps, crates, ice boxes, etc.

(c) 25% subsidy on the cost of feed limited to Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) per crop per ha for 2 crops in a year.
