Sub:- Regarding Quotation for Hiring of Private Fishing Vessel for Sagar Kavach (Goa) 01/25

Sealed Quotation is here by invited for the hiring of total 08 nos. of fishing vessels from 22nd to 24th April 2025 for the coastal security exercise "Sagar Kavach (Goa) 01/25" which is scheduled on 22nd to 24th April 2025. The Quotations shall be submitted to the Office of the Directorate of Fisheries, Dayanand Bandodkar Marg Panaji on or before 11.00 a.m. on 04/04/2024.

Terms and conditions are as follows:

1. The length of the fishing vessel shall be at least 13 mts. and should be attached with small dingy/ canoe to enable operations during the exercise.
2. A single vender can supply maximum of 2 nos. of fishing vessel.
3. Fishing vessels participated earlier in the exercise shall not be allowed to participate in the upcoming exercise.
4. The fishing vessels should be equipped with communication, and safety equipments such as VHF, GPS, lifejackets and life buoys, fire fighting appliance etc and their should be at least 5 nos. of crew on vessel i.e 1 tandel and 4 crew members..
5. Fishing vessel should be seaworthy and should be in good condition.
6. Fishing vessels should carry sufficient amount of diesel to venture in the deep sea, ration for crew members and water for 3-4 days to cater the basic needs of the crew members.

7. Fishing vessels should have proper lights and navigational signals so as to ply during the night time.
8. Fishing vessel shall be registered under merchant Shipping Act and should be carrying valid Vessel Registration Certificate and fishing licence certificate.
9. All the crew members boarding the vessel should mandatorily carry QR coded Aadhaar card,
10. Fishing vessels should be given at the disposal of Directorate of fisheries for further necessary communication and instructions.
11. Tandel and crew members of the fishing vessel shall strictly follow the instruction given on time to time by Directorate of Fisheries and Security agency during the exercise.
12. The quoted amount should include the rate of all charges including hiring of fishing vessel, diesel, crew members including taxes (if any) etc.
13. GST/taxes, if any shall be indicated separately.
14. The fishing vessels will have to be ensured by the supplier at his own cost to ensure safe delivery. The Department will not be responsible for the damage during the exercise.
15. Fishing vessels supplied will be finally accepted only after the inspection by the competent authority appointed for the purpose by the Director of Fisheries whose decision in this regards will be final.
16. The payment towards the supply made will be done after submission of attendance certificate from the concern security agency and submission of the bill by the supplier.
17. The Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right to negotiate the rate if fishing vessels are found proper as per the specification.
18. The Directorate of Fisheries reserves the right to accept or reject the quotation without assigning any reason thereof.
