(C) REGISTRATION & LICENCING OF FISHING VESSELS (TRAWLER, PURSE-SEINER, SPORTS FISHING VESSEL & CANOES) & FISHING NET/GEAR.

The Department Registers Fishing Vessels in the State of Goa under Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 and Rules, 1988. The Fishing Vessel License is issued under Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 and Rules 1982.

The applicant has to obtain prescribed form from Fisheries Officer/Fisheries Surveyor posted in the concerned blocks/ jetties and the applications duly filled along with the documents mentioned there in should be submitted to the Fisheries Officers who consecutively will inspect if, need be for certain services and after conducting necessary inspection, the application along with the Inspection Report and prescribed fees is forwarded to the Head Office from concerned Fisheries Officer through the respective Blocks/Jetties.

The Department also registers Fishing Net/Gear and issues Fishing Net/Gear Licences under Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980, its rule 1982 and its amendment in the State of Goa. As per Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Act & Rules there under, A.S.F/F.O. are authorized to register, issue or renew licenses for fishing net or gear.

(D) ENFORCEMENT, COASTAL SECURITY AND SAFETY OF FISHERMEN

The Department has enacted Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Act 1980 and its Rules 1982. If any person contravenes the provision of Acts and Rules, the Authorized officer of concerned Jetty/ Block refers the cases in the Court of Adjudicating Officer for necessary actions.

The Department plays an important role in Coastal Security with the help of Stake holders, like Indian Navy, Coast Guard and Coastal Police.

Fishermen are made aware about the various weather alerts. The Department is having following contact number and e-mail ID for communication on weather warning, complaints regarding illegal fishing activities, distress etc.

(E) Coastal Aquaculture Authority Act 2005

The Coastal Aquaculture Authority (CAA) was established under the Coastal Aquaculture Authority Act, 2005 and notified vide Gazette Notification dated 22/12/2005. The main objective of the Authority is to regulate Coastal Aquaculture activities in Coastal Areas in order to endure sustainable development without causing damage to the Coastal Environment.

The Authority is empowered to make regulations for the construction and operation of Aquaculture Farms in coastal areas, inspection of farms to ascertain their environmental impact, registration of aquaculture farms, fixing standards for inputs and effluents, removal or demolition of coastal aquaculture farms, which cause pollution etc.

The Coastal Aquaculture Authority (CAA) has amended the CAA Rules 2005 and has constituted Sub-Divisional Level Committee (SDLC) and District Level Committee (DLC) as per the Notification G.S.R. 216 (E) dated 22/03/2022 which is issued by Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India.

The Sub-Divisional Level Committee (Block wise) and District Level Committee is constituted by the Government of Goa in order to ease and speed up the process of recommendation for registration/renewal as per the guidelines for registration of coastal aquaculture farms which is notified vide official State Gazette No.8, Series II, dated 26/05/2022.

(F) Other Services

I. Kisan Credit Card (KCC)

In the budget 2018-19 the Union Government had announced their decision to extend the facilities of Kisan Credit Card (KCC) to Fishermen/ Fish Farmers and Animal Husbandry Farmers to meet their working capital requirements.

Purpose: The KCC facility will meet the Short Term Credit requirements of rearing of animals, birds, fish, shrimps, other aquatic organisms, capture of fish etc.

Beneficiary: The Fishermen/ Fish Farmer who own or lease Registered Fishing Vessel/Boat, possesses necessary Fishing License/Permission for fishing in Estuary and Sea, Fish Farming/Mariculture Activities in Estuaries and Open Sea and any other State specific fisheries and allied activities.

The eligible Fishermen/ Fish Farmer should apply to the respective Bank for availing the KCC facility.

II. Group Accidental Insurance Scheme

Under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), the Central Government has introduced this Scheme on 12/11/2020.

Purpose: The main objective of the Scheme is to provide insurance cover for fisher towards accidental death. The 'fishers' will also mean fishworkers, fish farmers and any other category of persons directly involved in fishing and fisheries related allied activities.

Beneficiary: The applicant should be aged between 18 years (completed) and 70 years (age nearer birthday). The applicant should be engaged in fishing related activities

The compensation available under the Scheme is as follows: -

- (a) **Death:** 100% CSI of Rs.5.00 Lakhs;
- (b) **Permanent Total Disability:** 100% CSI of Rs.5.00 Lakhs;
- (c) **Permanent Partial Disability:** upto Rs.2.50 Lakhs and
- (d) **Hospitalization for PPD:** Rs.25,000/-.

III. Registration of Fish Sellers and Fish Trader

In order to bring all the Fish Traders and Fish Vendors under the ambit of the Fisheries Department, the Department has started registration of Fish Sellers and Fish Traders. This will help the department to identify/recognize the fishermen from different localities/communities and the department could maintain the database of all fishermen all over the State. This will also allow the Department to have a control on the number of Fish Trader operating in the State of Goa thereby protecting the interest of the local fishermen of the State.

(G) TRAINING COURSES

Training in Fisheries

1) Training Programme at Fisheries Training Centre Ela, Old Goa.

Every year 25 fisher youths are being trained in the Departmental Training course of 6 month's duration with a stipend of Rs.1000/- per month and Rs.100/- per head per fishing trip allowances is paid to the students as per the existing pattern of assistance.

2) Short Term Training Programme.

Short Term Training Programme are imparted to fisher youth, fish farmers, entrepreneurs etc. Interested in gaining in-hand training as well as theoretical knowledge in Fisheries oriented aspects. The Training is held at Fisheries Training Centre, Ela Dauji, Old Goa.

3) The Training Course at CIFNET, Cochin.

This Directorate deputed the candidates for training courses at Central Institute of Fisheries, Nautical and Engineering, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Government of India, Fine Arts Avenue, Cochin and its units at Chennai and Visakhapatnam for following courses.

- (i) **Vessel Navigator Course:** - Duration of course 24 months.
- (ii) **Marine Fitter Course:** - Duration of course 24 months.

4) B.Sc. (Fisheries) at Dr. Balasaheb Sawant, Konkan Krishi Vidhyapeet, Dapoli, Ratnagiri District, Maharashtra: -
