## CONDITIONS GOVERNING SELECTION AND DEPUTATION OF STUDENTS FOR DEGREE IN FISHERIES SCIENCES

- 1. The candidates should apply in the prescribed Proforma.
- 2. The candidates should be resident of Goa for minimum period of 15 years.
- 3. Candidate must have appeared for the entrance exams conducted by ICAR or NEET.
- 4. XII Std. (Science) passed in 10+2 pattern with 50% (P,C,B & English) from Goa Board for Secondary & Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Maths and English. Those who have not offered Mathematics shall have to complete deficiency courses as prescribed by respective University.

## 5. Selection of Candidates:

- A. Selection of Candidates for B.F.S.c (Bachelor of Fisheries Science): The selection will be based on merit. Marks obtained for Physics, Chemistry and Biology in qualifying exam shall be taken as points and weightage would be given as below:
- i. Student coming from Farmer/Fishing family having land in his/her name or in name of his/her parent or paternal parent as seen in land index Form I & XIV for B.F.S.c./Fishermen Certificate from Competent Authority:- 10 points
- ii. Student holding NCC "B" or "C" certificate or NSS camp with aggregate 240 hrs . 2 points
- iii. Student who have participated in inter collegiate games/sports 2 points
- iv. Student having Math's as subject 6 points.
- v. Maximum added points 20 points.
- 6. Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in case of O.B.C. candidates should be attached.
- 7. Candidates applying for the posts under quota reserved for Ex-Servicemen should indicate on their application form whether they belong to SC/ST/OBC or UR category along with necessary certificate.
- 8. The preference and category to which students apply should be clearly specified in the Application Form.
- 9. The selected candidates will have to make his/her own arrangements for stay at the institution of studies either through hostel or their own.
- 10. The selected candidates should make their own arrangements for travel from Goa to the college for studies.
- 11. The candidate should attach the self attested photocopies of the marks list of XIIth Science, School Leaving Certificate, the Residential Certificate, Birth Certificate, Aadhar card and other certificates as applicable.
- 12. The candidates shall produce the original certificates when demanded.
- 13. The selected candidates will have to convey his/her acceptance of the selection on or before the last day indicated on the notice of the merit list.
- 14. The selected candidate will pay all his tuition fees, hostel fees, and deposits as applicable to the students on his/her own after the final selection and admission of the College.

- 15. The selected candidate will have to furnish a security of Rs 2,000/- to this Directorate in the Form of Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank payable at Panaji in the name of Directorate of Fisheries, Panaji to affirm his/her candidature at the time of acceptance.
- 16. The Security Deposit of the candidates will be forfeited in favour of the Government for his/her failure to report to the college within the stipulated time or for abandoning the study in the middle of year.
- 17. The Security Deposit will be refunded to the applicant after successful completion of the studies duly supported by a letter from the college of studies to that effect.
- 18. The candidates will be required to undergo medical fitness test as directed by the college of studies.
- 19. The selected candidates will have to abide to all the terms and conditions of admission, study, behavior, discipline, etc., as specified from time to time by the college and the Directorate of Fisheries, Panaji-Goa. The selected candidates will have to execute bond on Rs 50/- non-judicial stamp paper affirming to adhere to these conditions.
- 20. The students interested in seeking admission for B.F.S.c should apply to Directorate of Fisheries, Dayanand Bandodkar Marg, Panaji-Goa.
- 21. The last date for submission of completed application form to the Directorate of Fisheries, Dayanand Bandodkar Marg, Panaji-Goa, is 10/11/2025.
- 22. The list of the eligible candidates as per the merit will be displayed on the Departmental notice board and will be uploaded on departmental website www.fisheries.goa.gov.in.
- 23. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on departmental notice board/ up-loaded on departmental website www.fisheries.goa.gov.in and conveyance of acceptance from any of the selected candidates if not received within stipulated time, offer to next reserve candidates will be considered.
- 24. Display of subsequent lists will be on departmental notice board/ announced on departmental website.
- 25.It may be noted that no individual letter will be sent to selected candidates. It is responsibility of the candidates to see the departmental notice board or website.
- 26. After completion of admission formalities the students should submit a copy of Attendance certificate (for each financial year individually), Bank Mandate Form and copy of Results every financial year to this Directorate, for release of stipend.
